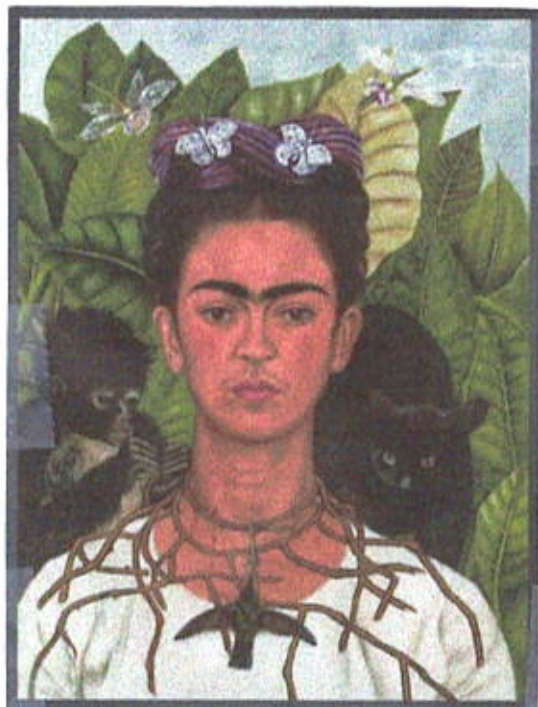


THE MAKING OF AN ICON – FRIDA KAHLO EXHIBITION

At the Tate Modern on Wednesday 28th October 2026.



This exhibition is about the extraordinary story of how Frida Kahlo became one of the most influential artists of all time, a cultural phenomenon and an internationally recognised commercial icon.

30 of the artist's most iconic works will be showcased alongside treasured garments, jewellery, photographs and memorabilia.

In addition, over 200 works by her contemporaries and the later generation artists she inspired, will also be on display, celebrating her lasting impact on those who continue to reimagine and reclaim her remarkable story.

Our tour starts with a private lecture in the auditorium from 1.30pm to 2.30pm, after which we will view the exhibition in groups of 25 every 15 minutes.

The cost is as follows :

Tate members	£24	to include lecture and admission
Art Fund members	£32.50	to include lecture and admission
Non members	£45	to include lecture and admission

There is a coach available from Midhurst bus station leaving at 10am which should arrive at the Tate Modern around 12 noon which leaves ample time for everyone to purchase lunch/refreshments before the lecture. The coach will leave between 4.15 and 4.30pm back to Midhurst bus station. The cost is £20 per person, **provided there is a full complement of 50 people.**
