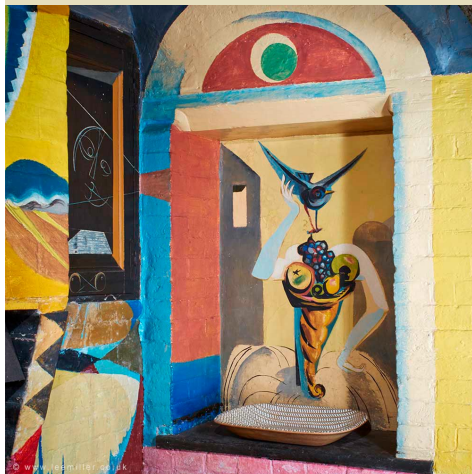




THURSDAY 25TH SEPTEMBER 2025

Tucked away in the Sussex countryside **Farleys** conjures up an extraordinary atmosphere that testifies to its position as a meeting place for some of the key personalities in 20th century art.

Lee Miller and Roland Penrose moved to the Sussex countryside to live at **Farleys** in 1949. For the 35 years that followed they filled their home with a collection of contemporary art treasures and were visited by some of the key personalities of twentieth century art.



Today **Farleys** is the base of the Lee Miller Archives and The Penrose Collection from which books, exhibitions and reproduction rights are privately managed by the family.

We will be visiting on **Thursday 25th September 2025** and having a guided tour of the house in the morning and the opportunity to visit the Garden and Sculptures in the afternoon.
